

FULL PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR PUBLICATION IN PROCEEDINGS THE iNELTAL CONFERENCE 2020

- Full papers for publication in proceedings must be written in English within 2500 – 3000 words.
- Full papers should be submitted through the presenter's account **by 30 November 2020 (optional, post-conference)**.
- The name of the file is: **Name of Lead Presenter_Name of Affiliation**
- **Full papers that are below the standards in terms of language and contents will not be published.**
- When you submit your full paper, please indicate whether you would like your paper to be reviewed for: **(1) Proceedings with ISBN**, or **(2) Indexed Proceedings**.
- For publication in the **Indexed Proceedings**, you will need to pay additional fee, the amount of which will be informed after papers are submitted.
- No fees are charged for publication in the **Proceedings with ISBN**.
- Full paper submission should adhere to the following guidelines:

a. Outline

(1) Empirically based paper

- Title
- Name, institution, address of the institution, and email address
- Abstract (not exceeding 200 words)
- Introduction (containing background of the study and the state of the art of your topic/the research gap)
- Method
- Findings and Discussion
- Conclusions
- References

(2) Conceptually based paper

- Title
- Name, institution, address of the institution, and email address
- Abstract (not exceeding 200 words)
- Introduction
- Body (Headings in the body part are based on the focus of the paper)
- Conclusions
- References

b. Technicalities

- References (please conform to the requirements of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association 6th edition.)
- Sample paper is available in a separate file. We suggest that you write over the paper so your paper's format will be in line with the guidelines.
